- if the exemption is allowed, the school will plan another activity for the child during this period;
- if the exemption is refused, the School Board must justify its refusal in writing; 4- In case of a refusal, the parent should present a "Request to reconsider" to the Council of Commissioners (the Request application is available on the site of the CLÉ): www.coalition-cle.org
 5- If the refusal is maintained by Council of Commissioners, the parent informs the CLE: an appeal will be made to the Superior Court.
